They are

- Starter woman entrepreneurs who have the ability to solve social problems and contribute to realize prosperous ASEAN
- Nominated by AMS government
- One entrepreneur per country
- Started her own business only after December 2012 (less than 5 years experience with current business)
- The first generation of the business
- Awarded at significant pitch contest / business presentation contest in her country on her current business
- Can be a role model to others

Supporting companies

They are

- Successful companies who wish to support fresh starter women entrepreneurs directly by providing their own service, network etc.
- Interested in being a part of the ecosystem to support fresh starter women entrepreneurs

Mentors

They are

- Successful women entrepreneurs who are interested in mentoring junior fellow women entrepreneurs
- Also act as supporting companies, if they are interested in
