

## **Approaches to Bridge Education Gap in ASEAN** through Online Learning

The ASEAN-Japan Centre (AJC) is organizing a webinar on "Approaches to Bridge Education Gap in ASEAN through Online Learning".

The methods of education have been changing drastically due to COVID-19 and technological development. In Japan, use of online lectures in schools increased sharply to 51% in 2021<sup>1</sup> from 13% in 2020. However, implementation of online lectures is not the only way of utilizing technology in school education. Cross-border exchanges and pursuits of other methods of continual learning are being carried out in various countries and regions.

In this connection, we invited a lecturer from Manabie, a company founded in Singapore in April 2019 which is into the development of online learning apps and running cram schools mainly in Viet Nam, to discuss the current state of online education in Southeast Asia, and how education could transform in the future.

It is our hope that this webinar will be useful for those who are interested in education and its digitalization.
