ASEAN-Japan Centre is going to co-host a webinar “Indonesian Update: New Policy and Economic Outlook” with the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia and Bank Indonesia.

With the global pandemic, the economic outlook of ASEAN is in question. As of second quarter of 2021, the domestic economic recovery in Indonesia has endured, primarily driven by exports, fiscal spending and non-building investment. Early indicators in June 2021, including retail sales and PMI, confirmed a solid ongoing economic recovery.

Indonesia’s economic growth is predicted to regain an upward trajectory in the fourth quarter of 2021, as the vaccination rollout and strict compliance to health protocols allow for greater public mobility along with ongoing stimuli and improved export performance.

This webinar will provide the latest information on Indonesia’s outlook. Bank Indonesia Policy Mix will be the focal point, particularly on digitalization in payment system to maintain macroeconomic and financial system stability, while supporting efforts to improve the national economy.
